



EARLY LITERACY ACTIVITIES LOWER ELEMENTARY

Set your child for success this school year!

Read a book with your child
for 20 minutes a day.

Ensure daily school
attendance.

Ask your child's teacher about
their reading progress.

Ask, "When is a time that you felt (happy/sad/angry)?"	Have daily conversations during family meal.	Cook with your child. Read the recipe or labels on ingredients.	Practice identifying sounds in words.	Visit the library (and get a card if you don't have one).
Practice a new word of the day.	Have your child read to you every day.	Ask your child to retell what happened in a show or movie.	Play age-appropriate music and sing along.	Say a word and come up with as many rhyming words as you can.
Challenge your child to read as many labels as they can in the grocery store.	Play kids' charades.	Follow us @ReadWithMeNV on Instagram, Facebook, & YouTube.	Talk to your child about their day at school.	Enable closed-captioning during screen time.
Encourage your child to ask if they hear a word they don't know.	Ask your child to explain games they play on the phone or tablet.	Practice following print with a finger from left to right.	Have your child help you write a shopping list.	Download educational apps and practice literacy skills.
Help your child write a letter to a friend or family member.	Explore read-aloud/text-to-speech websites.	Spell out the letters in signs that you see.	Start a daily journaling time.	Work with your child to write out a daily schedule or routine.
